- 3. Local Resource Concerns "On Ag Lands" Al Oliver, District Conservationist USDA/NRCS
 - a. USDA Organization and Services
 - b. EQIP program
- 4. Local Resource Concerns "Beyond the Farm Boundary" Allen Moore
 - a. SWAPA (soil erosion, water quality, air condition, plant management, animal management)
 - b. Consider adding a 6th element: people
 - c. Often there are more challenges off the farm than on the farm
- 5. Resource Concerns Allen Moore
 - a. Conservation Education (i.e. DSWCD Envirothon, Speech Contest, Poster Contest, Photo Contest)
 - b. Flooding (i.e. NRCS Emergency Watershed Protection Program)
 - c. Waste Management (i.e. septic tanks)
 - d. Water Quality (i.e. runoff)
 - e. Water Quantity (i.e. SJRWMD Water Conservation)
 - f. Shoreline Erosion
 - g. Forest Management
 - h. Parks (Need conservation planning to enhance parks)
 - i. Natural Disaster
 - j. Other (i.e. grants facilitated by partnerships, urban agriculture)
- 6. Facilitated Discussion
 - a. Puts people with resource concerns together with people who have access to solutions
 - b. Susan Carew (DCPS) Need to increase participation in Green Champions because only 5-6 of 20 high schools participate
 - c. Margo Moehring (NEFRC) Researching cultivating food systems, economic development, critical infrastructure
 - d. Geoff Sample (SJRWMD) Blue School Grants available and cost-shares often go unused
 - e. Margo Moehring (NEFRC) EDA funding available to work on resiliency, natural disasters, shoreline erosion. Suggests SJRWMD, DSWCD and NEFRC meet to work on a project together and apply for funding
 - f. Paul Soares (DCPS) String recycling efforts at DCPS, Green Champions meets 3 times per year

- g. Jennifer Casey (DSWCD) Working on food forests and permaculture in the urban core
- h. Josh Rosenberg (DSWCD) We need more school programs that teach the importance of biodiversity. Also, we need to grow things around retention ponds in the area and not leave them bare
