Chairperson's Remarks: We need to have a last quarter shift of focus because of the bill recently passed (HB 1103/SB 1624). Budget & compliance might start investigating all special district boards so we need to do a heightened job and be ready for any investigation. We need to prepare for an audit with FDACS.
